There will be day motorcycle rides, campfires, pool tournaments, fishing tournaments, fun poker games and whatever else you may want to do. For those who want to show off their trout fishing skills, river Jon boats with motors will be available for rent (navigational experience suggested) and fishing guides available for hire. If you have never fished a river with flowing water, it is **highly recommended** to reserve an experienced guide, with Gene's Resort, for fly or bait fishing. Guides must be reserved in advance for guaranteed availability.

Accommodations consist of one, two, and three bedroom cabins and/or two or three story lodges and Grand Suites. The cabins, lodges, and Grand Suites all have fully equipped kitchens and bed linens. The lodges and Grand Suites all have a pool table. All accommodations will be on a first come first serve basis. If you want to book a riverfront cabin, make your reservations now!
